



# HISTORY

## HISTORICAL HERITAGE OF HUMANITY

*Port and Monumental Complex: Cartagena has the most extensive fortifications in South America. A zone system divides the city into three neighborhoods: San Pedro, with the cathedral and numerous Andalusian-style palaces; San Diego, where merchants and the middle class lived; and Gethsemane, the 'popular neighborhood'.*

*The city is the sum of its incredible attributes and qualities: its colonial, republican and modern architecture, its cultural festivals, its outstanding gastronomic offer, its unique hotel and tourist infrastructure; and its multiple non-traditional spaces such as plazas, colonial mansions and fortifications that can only be described as unique.*



## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

*To avoid setbacks during your stay in Colombia, it is useful to consider some general health and vaccination recommendations.*

**Vaccines** *Currently, vaccinations are not required to enter Colombia.*

**Medicines and health services.**

*If you take medications, it is essential that you carry your prescription with you so that you can purchase them at a pharmacy or drugstore, if necessary. Remember to always have on hand any documentation related to any special health conditions you may have that should be considered in the event of an emergency.*

**Medical Insurance** *We also strongly recommend that you take out international medical insurance before traveling to ensure full coverage should you require medical attention.*

*Another key tip to follow is to use sunscreen and stay well hydrated at all times.*

*Lastly, if you have any food allergies, be sure to always ask about the ingredients used in the meals you order.*
